

BRIDGING LOCATIONS

Howard County

- Centennial Park: Centennial Lake Park has a couple bridges on the lake path: one may be seen from Centennial Road just North of 108. The other is in the woods (take the lake path from the tennis courts/playground and go left- the bridge is on that side of the lake.)
- Columbia: in the Village of Running Brook, at the park at Wild Lake there is a cute bridge over a stream, (You can see this from 175 a little East of Col. Mall).
- Lilliput Lane (CY Enterprises: 410-489-7291): Daisies & Brownies can do animal try-it, petting zoo plus
- Font Hill Park (2 nice bridges in the park; near the first one(right off Font Hill Drive) is a great grassy area for picnicking.
- Warfield Park (off McClintock)
- Along walking paths in Columbia (ex. near Clemens Crossing)
- Bridge on nature trail behind Lisbon Elementary School
- Coopers Park in Sykesville
- Clementine Peterson Center (behind Valley View toward beginning of sensory trail.
- Clementine Peterson Center: use stage as a bridge
- Bridge that can be borrowed from Peterson or used on stage (This bridge has been borrowed and not returned!)
- Borrow from other GS Service Units (Maureen Helfrich-SU54)
